On January 1, 2016, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) new quality control option under CLIA, the Individualized Quality Control Plan (IQCP) became effective. This presentation will discuss an overview of the three sections of IQCP, the Risk Assessment, the Quality Control Plan, and the Quality Assessment. Participants will be introduced to educational materials created to facilitate an understanding of IQCP as well as what a laboratory can expect a CLIA surveyor to ask to review for assessing compliance with IQCP.
